Dear Parents,

Welcome to our Term One Primary Afternoon Activity Programme. At LICS we regard these as an important part of your child's education and, although not compulsory, please encourage your child to participate in at least one activity during the course of the week.

Afternoon Activities begin on **Monday 7th September** and end on **Friday 27th November**. Please indicate on the attached form your child's preference for each day. **Return this to the school office by Monday 31st August 2009**. Activity allocation is on a first-come-first served basis.

Although we understand about the occasional late pick-up of your child, please be sure that your child is collected promptly after their activity, as persistent late collection could see your child being excluded from activities for the rest of the term.

Our main sport this term is swimming and if your child has signed up for Junior Team swimming, you may find your child is required to attend a swimming Gala outside the school on a Friday. You will be informed about these events nearer the time.

Once your child has chosen an activity we expect them to attend this for the whole term. We feel it is unfair for the children who were unable to get a place on an activity, if those children that were selected fail to attend. Therefore, if for any reason your child misses an activity please give the teacher concerned a written note explaining the absence.

If an activity has a low number of participants, this activity may be cancelled and your child will be given another option.

If the activity is a sporting one, please ensure your child is correctly dressed in his/her LICS PE kit, including a hat.

If your child attends Kumon on a Monday or Thursday, please ask them to attend their activity first, as late arrival disrupts the group.

I hope that you and your child will be able to select an interesting and enjoyable programme for this term. If you have any queries, please do not hesitate to contact the Vice Principal or the teacher conducting the activity.

The following fees have to be paid for the specific activities:

- 1) Ballet – this activity is run by outside dance teachers – Anja and Paula. Students should come in dance or ballet clothes. **The charge is 120 USD per term, payable to Anja in the first two weeks of the ballet term.** Failure to do so will result in your child not being able to continue. The last lesson will be on 30th November.
- 2) Bead work/knitting: a charge of **50,000 ZMK per term** should be paid to the teacher for the purchase of materials used during the activity. Students will learn to sew simple, practical items eg. bags.
- 3) Cookery will incur a fee of **100,000 ZMK per term**, payable to Mrs. Chileshe on the first Tuesday. This enables us to buy ingredients.
- 4) Monkeynastics is a fun filled activity to improve balance, coordination and self-esteem in young children. **The charge is 250,000 ZMK per term or 35,000 ZMK per class, payable to the coach.**
- 5) LICS passports is based on a Geography programme that begun 15 years ago at an elementary school in Olympia, Washington. Today the programme has over 25,000 participants all over the world. Members will sharpen their world Geography skills and will study a new country-culture, tradition, music, arts, food and dance each week. They will earn passport 'stamps', mastery of skills and Geography expertise.
- 6) Chess is run by Mr Ngulube: **20,000 ZMK per session, payable to the teacher.** All abilities welcome. We will be having friendly matches against other clubs.
- 7) Karate will be taken by an outside coach – Patrick, and is run solely by him. If you have any queries contact him on 0977 49 40 63. **The cost of each lesson is 20,000 ZMK, payable to the coach.**
- 8) Cricket Years 1 – 4. This activity is held by an outside coach and is suitable for beginners and intermediate players; it will incur a cost of **120,000 ZMK per term, payable to the coach at the first session.**
- 9) Zambian Cultural Club: a charge of **50,000 ZMK per term** should be paid to the teachers for the purchase of materials used during the activity.
