Dear Parents,

Re: Afternoon Activities - Secondary School

After a very busy and successful afternoon activities programme in the Secondary School in term 2, we are pleased to share with you our plans for next term.

It is our hope that organising the activities now, will also give us an opportunity to have comprehensive registers ready for the start of next term.

Students are individually responsible to commit to the activity that they have signed up for. If they cannot attend an activity, they must produce a written note from parents to excuse themselves. Lateness and absenteeism will result in a verbal warning on the first occasion, as well as notification to parents. Repeated absences will result in an afternoon detention. We appreciate your support in this matter.

Some of our students attend Mosque school, Language schools, horse riding and music lessons etc outside of school in the afternoons. We encourage these outside school activities and ask that you please indicate them on the reply slip so that we, as staff, are aware of your son/daughter's commitments.
