At LICS we value highly the pride we have in ourselves and our school. **Brand LICS reflects** our image the high standards that we strive to uphold.

Our uniform items and how we wear them and how we carry ourselves; while embracing the realities of a bustling progressive school and a more informal mode; must be worn with dignity and with respect towards the image of the school.

The following points must be adopted as the basic tenets for wearing our uniform:

- Students not upholding the LICS dress and uniform code will face appropriate sanctions as defined by each department.
- The uniform must at all times be worn with regard to the principle of modesty and appropriateness.
- Clothes should always be neat and freshly washed and ironed. Seams, buttons, and hems must be in good repair. Faded and worn items must be replaced.

LICS team sports shirt and tracksuit - as required for team members.</p>	





General Rules about Dress and Appearance

The following regulations apply, **without exception**.

1. All daily wear must be **worn correctly** to and from school on all occasions. Students are expected to wear their uniform with pride in as well as outside of the school environment.
2. All uniform items and valuables brought to school must be **clearly marked** with the student's name
3. When it is essential that a student wear something other than the correct uniform, e.g. because of illness or injury, the school must be consulted for advice on what is acceptable.
4. The wearing of jewellery is restricted. Students may wear watches and medical bracelets (if necessary). Girls may wear simple studs or sleepers (one per earlobe).
5. No make-up is to be worn, including nail polish.
6. Students travelling home from sports practice and fixtures may wear their appropriate sports uniform
7. When students leave the classroom at the end of the day they should be wearing their uniform correctly.
8. All hats must be removed in the classroom or when entering a building.
9. When attending interviews or meetings with the Headmaster and/or teachers, school uniform must be worn.

Appearance

BOYS

- TO BE FINALISED: No outlandish hairstyles will be allowed. Hair should be kept neat, clean and not so obvious that it attracts attention.
- Facial hair to be shaven – no beards / moustaches, etc.
- Permitted jewellery - wrist watch and medical alert chain / bracelet.

GIRLS

- No outlandish hairstyles will be allowed. Hair should be neat, clean and not so obvious that it attracts attention.
- Permitted jewellery - one simple sleeper or stud per earlobe, wrist watch and medical alert chain / bracelet.
- No make-up is to be worn whatsoever.
